Dear Participant:

Effective July 1, 2004, the Board of Trustees has chosen Rx Options, Inc. to administer the prescription drug benefit program.

Enclosed is your new Prescription Drug identification card. Please check the card(s) to make certain that the information is accurate and up-to-date. If you find any errors, please contact the Fund Office at 1-800-435-2388. You should discard your old prescription card labeled "NPA" after July 1, 2004.

In order to obtain prescription benefits, please present your new ID card to any participating pharmacy. A listing of the major participating pharmacies in our area is printed on the reverse side of this letter. If your pharmacy is not listed, contact the Help Desk at 1-800-361-4542 to determine if they participate.

Please note that the Trustees have elected to **continue with the current prescription plan at this time**. The Plan will continue to require the following co-payments:

	Retail Program*	Mail Order Program **
Generic	\$5	\$5
Brand	\$15 co-pay or 20% of the drug cost whichever is greater	\$15 co-pay or 20% of the drug cost whichever is greater
Brand Name with generic equivalent	The greater of a \$50 co-pay or 20% of the drug cost plus the cost difference between the brand and its generic equivalent	The greater of a \$50 co-pay or 20% of the drug cost plus the cost difference between the brand and its generic equivalent

All participants who use maintenance medication are encouraged to use the mail order program. The savings will benefit both you and the Fund since your co-payment for a 90-day supply is the same as a retail prescription. Enclosed is a brochure from drugstore.com, the new mail service pharmacy, fully describing the benefits of the mail order program.

Also enclosed are new Health Fund identification cards which should be used for all services effective July 1, 2004. Please note that your social security number no longer appears on the card. It has been replaced with a group number and employee number. Please destroy your old medical identification cards at that time.
